

### 2005-06 Professional Goals School Leader

The following professional goals will form a significant part of the overall 2005-06 performance evaluation for the School Leader.

Goal #1: Increase the visibility of the school in our sending communities through enhanced public relations and recruitment efforts.

Indicators:

- A. Monthly press releases regarding the school's programs and successes.
- B. Achieving 85% retention for each grade level
- C. Reaching a waiting list in each grade level by March 2006
- D. Developing new methods for public relations and recruitment

Goal #2: Accountability: Successful Site Visit and Dissemination of Best Practice

Indicators:

- A. Report from the Site Visit Team from the DOE states that the school is fulfilling its mission in the following areas:
  - Is the Academic Program a Success?
  - Is the School a Viable Organization?
  - Is the School Faithful to the Terms of its Charter?
- B. Faculty & school leaders present best practice workshops in a variety of venues.

Goal #3: Enhance School Culture and Sense of Community

Indicators:

- A. Increase in positive ratings by students, parents, and faculty on yearend school culture surveys when compared with the results of the 2004-05 surveys.
- B. Increase the number of assemblies and community building events by 50%.
- C. Reduction in student and faculty attrition when compared to the 2004-05 school year.

Indicators:

- A. Improved Advisory Program indicated on student survey
- B. Enhanced communication with parents as indicated on parent survey
- C. Redesigned Homework Club
- D. Increased support for IEP & 504 students as indicated on parent survey
